x Student must be a current NKU student both at the time of the competition/performance and at the time of funding disbursementSo **f** a student graduates in May and travels after graduation date they will not be eligible for this funding.

# **Award Funds**

- x Funds may only be applied to competition/performanteleted expenses including airfare, mileage, lodging, parking, and registration fees.
- x Forgroups requesting fundshe students and faculty agree follow all University rules and regulations related to student travel. Funds allowable by University regions will only be reimbursed after completion of trip with proper documentation.
